



  - The HOA will recoup all legal expenses via liens and or garnishment as a result of pursuing the above legal actions.


### O'Fallon Information Street Creep

#### O'Fallon Information Lateral Sewer Line Clog

- What do I do if I think I have a problem?
- The first step is to submit the application and hold harmless agreement along with your last year's paid Real Estate tax receipt, and a \$400.00 non-refundable application fee. The City of O'Fallon will perform a video inspection of the sewer lateral. The video inspection is needed to verify the nature and location of the defect.
- To provide the highest level of service to our residents, the City has an inhouse crew to perform all phases involved with the program. Services may include video inspection, lateral line location and repairs, if the defect is eligible under the program.


